

Thank you for your interest in pursuing a Christian education for your child. Please complete and return the application form and the enclosed documents along with a non-refundable application fee of \$125 (plus an additional \$50 for each sibling applying). Your student(s) will need to complete the student's questionnaire if applying for grades 2-12. You will also need to have the Pastor/Church Leader Form completed at your church and returned to Westminster.

- Students applying for grades PK4 through grade 12 will need to submit the enclosed school recommendation form to their current school. The completing school will then mail or fax it to Westminster directly.
- Placement testing for grades 6-12 is offered monthly. The testing dates are listed on the Westminster website, www.wcsmiami.org. Contact the Admissions Office at (305) 233-2030, ext. 209 to sign up for a testing date.
- Individual placement testing for Preschool and Elementary students will be scheduled by the Elementary office when all of the application documents have been received by the Westminster Admissions Office.
- A family interview is required for all applicants and will be scheduled when all admission documents have been received and all testing is completed.
- Upon receiving and accepting an offer of admission to Westminster Christian School, the family will be asked to complete and return enrollment documents, a signed contract and registration and matriculation fees. Registration and matriculation fees are non-refundable.
